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#### **Theft Deterrent System**

The theft deterrent system includes the following features to help protect your vehicle from theft.

#### Immobilizer system



The immobilizer system prevents the engine from being started in the event that an attempt is made to start the vehicle using an unregistered key. The security indicator light flashes to indicate that the system is set.

The system sounds the alarm and flashes light when an attempt to steal the vehicle is detected.

To set the alarm: close the side doors, back door and hood, and lock all doors. The indicator light comes on to indicate that the alarm is in its preparation state. When the indicator light begins to flash, the system is armed.

To deactivate or stop the alarm: start the engine, or unlock the doors using the entry function or the wireless remote control.

#### Steering lock



The steering lock is engaged when the driver's door is opened with the "ENGINE START STOP" switch OFF.







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

1 Fold down the seatback while pulling the seatback angle adjustment lever, and swing the whole seat up and forward.

2 Hook the holding strap to the assist grip and secure the seat by pulling its free end.

When returning the second seat to its original position, stow the holding strap.


#### Tumbling the third seats

Before tumbling the third seats, make sure the following items are in their stowed positions.

- Seat belt buckles: stowed in the seat cushion
- Outer seat belts: secured with the seat belt hangers
- Center seat belt: stowed in the cover set in the roof
- Center head restraint: stowed in the seat back

For the way of stowing, see the Owner's Manual.

► Vehicles with manual switches



1 Press and hold the third seat tumbling switch.

The switch for the left side third seat is found on the opposite side.

After the seat is tumbled, push the back of the seat cushion to lock it.

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#### Returning the third seats

Before returning the third seats, remove the seat hook covers from the floor and install them into the back of the seat cushion.





#### Inside Rear View Mirror

The mirror uses a sensor to detect light from vehicles behind and automatically reduces glare.



To turn automatic mode on/off, press the "AUTO" button. The indicator comes on when automatic mode is turned on.

#### Starting

With the electronic key on your person, the engine can be started by simply pressing the "ENGINE START STOP" switch, while depressing the brake pedal. (The mechanical key cannot be used to start the engine.)

#### Starting the engine



Make sure the parking brake is engaged and the shift lever is in "P".



#### Changing "ENGINE START STOP" switch modes

To change "ENGINE START STOP" switch modes without turning on the engine, press the "ENGINE START STOP" switch without depressing the brake pedal. The modes can be changed in the following order:



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#### **Multi-information** Display

The multi-information display shows information about your vehicle, including the items shown below.

#### Four-wheel Drive System

Use these switches to select following transfer and center differential modes.

▶ Four-wheel drive control switch



► Center differential lock/unlock switch



To select "L4" mode, push down and shift the switch backward. To select "H4" mode, shift the switch forward.

Use this switch when your vehicle's wheels get stuck in a ditch or when you are driving on a slippy or bumpy surface.

#### Intuitive Parking Assist (If Equipped)

The system uses a screen display and buzzer to inform the driver of obstacles near the vehicle when parking or driving at low speed.



ON/OFF

The indicator light comes on to inform the driver that the system is operational.

Cruise control allows the driver to maintain a constant speed without having to operate the accelerator pedal.

Use for highway driving or when traveling at a constant speed for long periods of time.

Setting the speed



 Press the "ON-OFF" button. The system will turn on.
 Accelerate or decelerate to the desired speed, and then push the lever down. This sets the speed in the cruise control memory.



1 To temporarily cancel the cruise control, pull the lever toward you. To resume the cruise control, push the lever up.

2 To turn the system off, press the "ON-OFF" button.


Adjusting the speed setting

The vehicle-to-vehicle distance control mode maintains the preset cruising speed as long as no vehicle is detected ahead.



#### **AVS (Adaptive Variable Suspension)**

AVS controls the suspension and steering wheel operation according to the road and driving conditions.



To select a driving mode, shift the damping mode select switch forward or backward.

### 4-Wheel AHC (Active Height Contro Suspension)

4-Wheel AHC adjusts the vehicle height in accordance with driving conditions.



#### Easy access mode

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

### 🔜 Headlights



1 The side marker, parking, tail, license plate and instrument panel lights turn on.

2 The headlights and all lights listed above turn on.

**3** The headlights and all lights listed above turn on/off automatically in accordance with ambient light levels.

To engage the high beams, push the lever forward. To flash the high beams, pull the lever and hold.

### AFS (Adaptive Front lighting System)

AFS improves visibility at intersections and on curves by automatically adjusting the direction of the light axis of the headlights according to vehicle speed and the degree of the tire angle that are controlled by steering input.



The system can be turned on and off using the "AFS OFF" switch.

### Headlight Cleaner (If Equipped)



The headlight cleaner can be used only when the "ENGINE START STOP" switch is in IGNITION ON mode and the headlights are on.

### Garage Door Opener The garage door opener can be programmed to operate garage doors, gates, entry doors, door locks, home lighting systems, security systems, and other devices. The garage door opener (HomeLink<sup>®</sup> Universal Transceiver) is manufactured under license from HomeLink $^{\mathbb{R}}$ . The HomeLink<sup>®</sup> compatible transceiver in your vehicle has 3 buttons which can be programmed to operate 3 different devices. - Emergency assistance
  - When you press the Emergency button, a priority call is placed to the Lexus Link Call Center with your vehicle's location. At the Call Center, the Lexus Link Advisor can determine your vehicle's location, communicate with you, and, if appropriate, contact the nearest emergency service provider.



- Stolen vehicle location assistance If your vehicle is stolen, call the Lexus Link Call Center and then select the option for Lexus Link.


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

#### Starting the engine



- 1 Depress the brake pedal.
- Touch the Lexus emblem side of the electronic key to the "ENGINE START STOP" switch.
   Press the "ENGINE START STOP" switch within 5 seconds after the buzzer sounds,

keeping the brake pedal depressed.



If the electronic key battery becomes depleted, replace it with a new battery. For instructions on replacing the battery, refer to the Owner's Manual. If you need further assistance, contact your Lexus dealer.

### If the engine does not star

Make sure that the correct operating procedures have been followed.



### Brake pedal

Make sure that the brake pedal is firmly depressed when attempting to start the engine.  $(\rightarrow P.25)$ 

### SOS.com Steering lock

Make sure that the steering lock is released.

To release the steering lock, gently turn the wheel left or right while pressing the "ENGINE START STOP" switch. ( $\rightarrow$ P.11)

### What to do if ...

### Electronic Key Alarm

The electronic key alarm uses an alarm and warning messages to indicate that the electronic key has been used improperly. Take appropriate measure in response to any warning messages that are displayed. In some cases, an alarm may sound without an accompanying warning message. If so, follow the correction procedure in the table below.
