


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

The smart access system with push-button start allows you to enter and exit the vehicle or start the engine by simply carrying the electronic key in your pocket or bag. For details on starting the engine, see page 10.

Theft Deterrent System

The theft deterrent system includes the following features to help protect your vehicle from theft.

Engine immobilizer system



The engine immobilizer system prevents the engine from being started in the event that an attempt is made to start the vehicle using an unregistered key.

The security indicator light flashes to indicate that the system is set.

Alarm

The system sounds the alarm and flashes lights when an attempt to steal the vehicle is detected.

To set the alarm: close the doors and hood, and lock all doors. The security indicator light comes on to indicate that the alarm is in its preparation state. When the indicator light begins to flash, the system is armed.

To deactivate or stop the alarm: turn the "ENGINE START STOP" switch to ACCESSORY or IGNITION ON mode, start the engine, or unlock the doors. **3U3.C**(

Steering lock

The steering wheel locks when the "ENGINE START STOP" switch is turned off and the driver's door is opened.

When the steering lock cannot be released, the green indicator light on the "ENGINE START STOP" switch will flash and a message will be shown on the multi-information display. To release it, press the "ENGINE START STOP" switch while gently turning the steering wheel left or right.

Engine (Ignition) Switch

With the electronic key on your person, the engine can be started by simply pressing the "ENGINE START STOP" switch, while depressing the brake pedal. (The mechanical key cannot be used to start the engine.)

Starting the engine



Make sure the parking brake is set and the shift lever is in P.

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

Stopping the engine

1 Set the parking brake and shift the shift lever to P. 2 Press the "ENGINE START STOP" switch.

If the shift lever is in a position other than P when turning off the engine, the "ENGINE START STOP" switch will be turned to ACCESSORY mode, not to OFF. To avoid unexpected battery discharge, make sure the lever is in the P poistion when stopping the engine.

To change the "ENGINE START STOP" switch mode without turning on the engine, press the "ENGINE START STOP" switch without depressing the brake pedal. The mode can be changed in the following order:



Intuitive Parking Assist (If Equipped)

The system uses a screen display and buzzer to inform the driver of obstacles near the vehicle when parking or driving at low speed.

Owners of models equipped with a navigation system should refer to the "Navigation System Owner's Manual".







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Cruise Control (If Equipped)

Cruise control allows the driver to maintain a constant speed without having to operate the accelerator pedal.

Use for highway driving or when traveling at a constant speed for long periods of time.



Dynamic Radar Cruise Control (If Equipped)

Dynamic radar cruise control supplements conventional cruise control with a vehicle-tovehicle distance control mode.



- Pressing and holding the head-up display main switch for more than 2 seconds changes the display to audio display on/off mode. Press the head-up display main switch to turn the audio display on/off.
- The head-up display may seem dark and hard to see when viewed through sunglasses, especially polarized sunglasses.





Automatic High Beam (If Equipped)

The Automatic High Beam uses an in-vehicle camera sensor to assess the brightness of streetlights, the lights of oncoming and preceding vehicles, etc., and automatically turns high beam on or off as necessary.



When all of the following conditions are fulfilled, high beam will be automatically turned on (after approximately 1 second):

- Vehicle speed is above approximately 20 mph (32 km/h).
- The area ahead of the vehicle is dark.
- There are no oncoming or preceding vehicles with headlights or tail lights turned on.

These ports can be used to connect a portable audio device and listen to it through the vehicle's speakers.




Safety Connect (If Equipped)

Safety Connect is a subscription-based telematics service that uses Global Positioning System (GPS) data and embedded cellular technology to provide safety and security features to subscribers. Safety Connect is supported by Lexus' designated response center, which operates 24 hours per day, 7 days per week.

Safety Connect service is available by subscription on select, telematics hardwareequipped vehicles.

Automatic Collision Notification*

In case of either airbag deployment or severe rear-end collision, the system is designed to automatically call the response center. The responding agent receives the vehicle's location and attempts to speak with the vehicle occupants to assess the level of emergency. If the occupants are unable to communicate, the agent automatically treats the call as an emergency, contacts the nearest emergency services provider to describe the situation, and requests that assistance be sent to the location.

Stolen Vehicle Location

If your vehicle is stolen, Safety Connect can work with local authorities to assist them in locating and recovering the vehicle. After filing a police report, call the Safety Connect response center at 1-800-25-LEXUS (1-800-255-3987) and follow the prompts for Safety Connect to initiate this service.

In addition to assisting law enforcement with recovery of a stolen vehicle, Safety-Connect-equipped vehicle location data may, under certain circumstances, be shared with third parties to locate your vehicle. Further information is available at Lexus.com.

Emergency Assistance Button (SOS)

In the event of an emergency on the road, push the "SOS" button to reach the Safety Connect response center. The answering agent will determine your vehicle's location, assess the emergency, and dispatch the necessary assistance required.

If you accidentally push the "SOS" button, tell the response-center agent that you are not experiencing an emergency.

Enhanced Roadside Assistance

Subscribers can push the "SOS" button to reach a Safety Connect response-center agent, who can help with a wide range of needs, such as: towing, flat tire, fuel delivery, etc. For a description of the Roadside Assistance services and their limitations, please see the Safety Connect Terms and Conditions, which are available at Lexus.com.

Destination Assist

After you tell the agent your choice of destination, its coordinates are sent wirelessly to your vehicle's navigation system.

eDestination

With the eDestination feature, you can go online, via the Lexus.com owner's Web site, to select and organize destinations of your choice and then wirelessly send them to your vehicle's navigation system.

You can store up to 200 locations online to access and update at any time.

Your locations can be organized into up to 20 personalized folders.

The subscription-based XM NavWeather[™] service allows the navigation system to display weather information on the map.

XM[®] NavTraffic^{*3}





What to do if ...

If the electronic key does not operate properly

Unlocking and locking the doors



To unlock or lock the vehicle, use the mechanical key. (driver's door only) The mechanical key is stored inside the electronic key.

1 Locks 2 Unlocks

Starting the engine



- Depress the brake pedal.
 Touch the Lexus emblem side of the electronic key to the "ENGINE START STOP" switch.
- 3 Press the "ENGINE START STOP" switch within 10 seconds of the buzzer, keeping the brake pedal depressed.

If the electronic key battery becomes depleted, replace it with a new battery. For instructions on replacing the battery, refer to the Owner's Manual. If you need further assistance, contact your Lexus dealer.

If the engine doesn't start

Make sure that the correct operating procedures have been followed.

Brake pedal

Steering wheel lock

Make sure that the brake pedal is firmly depressed when attempting to start the engine.

Make sure that the steering wheel lock is released.

To release it, press the "ENGINE START STOP" switch while gently turning the wheel left or right.

If the engine still does not start, see the Owner's Manual for more information or contact your Lexus dealer.

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What to do if ...

Electronic Key Alarm

The electronic key alarm uses an alarm and warning messages to indicate that the electronic key has been used improperly. Take appropriate measure in response to any warning messages that are displayed. In some cases, an alarm may sound without an accompanying warning message. If so, follow the correction procedure in the table below.

Alarm	Situation	Correction procedure
Exterior alarm sounds once for 10 seconds.	An attempt was made to lock the vehicle while a door was open.	Close all of the doors and lock the doors again.
Interior alarm pings continuously.	The "ENGINE START STOP" switch was turned to ACCESSORY mode while the driver's door was open (or the driver's door was opened while the "ENGINE START STOP" switch was in ACCES- SORY mode). The "ENGINE START STOP" switch was turned off while the driver's door	Close the driver's door.
